

- Christian Solidarity Worldwide Reports are emerging of religious leaders being among those detained amid unprecedented <u>nationwide protests</u> in Cuba ... In a post on Facebook, human rights activist and pastor Reverend Mario Félix Lleonart Barroso <u>reported</u> that the authorities had detained Yeremi Blanco y Yarian Sierra, two pastors from the Berean Baptist Mission in Matanzas. Reverend Yusniel Pérez Montejo, of the Eastern Baptist Convention, was reportedly detained in Songo-La Maya in Santiago, and a Catholic priest, Father Castor José Álvarez Devesa, was reportedly beaten and detained incommunicado by Cuban authorities in Camagüey in central Cuba. A number of religious groups published calls for peace, including The Methodist Church of Cuba ... Let us join them in praying for peace.
- For the **recently abducted** 140 children in Kaduna State, North West Nigeria and the 8 people abducted from the National TB and Leprosy Centre in Zaria.
